Ideal: (adj) the best or most suitable that something could possibly be in my opinion: Synonym: to me, from my point of view

Salary: (n) money that you receive as payment from the organization you work for usually paid to you every month

competitive: (adj) relating to competition; being better than others

Example: Competitive sports encourage children to work together as a team.

Example: Some Industries are not as competitive as they were in the past.

Supportive: (adj) helpful, encouraging

Example: Her family were really supportive throughout the divorce.

Atmosphere: (n) the feeling that an event or place gives you.

Example: The hotel had a lovely relaxed atmosphere.

Employer: (n) a person, company or organization that employs you

Colleague: (n) someone you work with Synonym: fellow worker, co-worker

Above all: more than everything else

Relevance: (n) the state of being relevant or related to something

Field: (n) a subject that people study or an area of activity that they are doing

Example: Peter is an expert in his field.

Distance: (n) the amount of space between two places or things

Plus point: an advantage or good feature

Commute: (v) to regularly travel a long distance to go to work
